As a residential hotel during the 1930s and 1940s, the Broadmoor offered a range of flexible accommodations and services that young professional players found attractive: Valet service, daily housekeeping, 12-hour laundry service, a restaurant with room service, and a bar that was a popular local nightspot.

Plus, the building was only three miles from Griffith Stadium at 7th and Florida – now the site of the Howard University Hospital.
